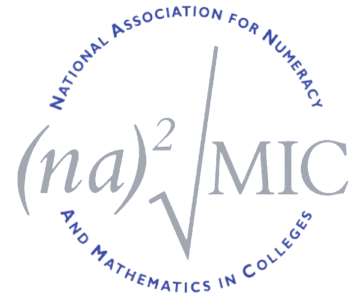


Dyslexia and Maths
