



International Statistical Literacy Project: Poster Competition 2018-2019

The International Statistical Literacy Project (ISLP) team have announced the International Poster Competition for 2018-2019. The competition invites candidates to design a statistical poster. The posters should reflect or illustrate usage analysis, interpretation and communication of statistics or statistical information.

The competition is open to teams of 2 to 5 students. There are three categories:

- Students born in 2003 and younger (lower secondary school);
 - Students born in 2000 and younger (upper secondary school);
- and
- Undergraduate students in university/college (Bachelor's degree students or equivalent, no age limit).

Overall winners are to be announced and their posters displayed at the 62nd World Statistics Congress of the International Statistical Institute during August 2019.
